At the outset, Mr. Naveen Singh Panwar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has stated on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh that in pursuance of the orders dated 14.06.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he has fully cooperated with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial investigation. He further submitted that although the petitioner is involved in 9 more cases but none of the cases pertain to the NDPS Act and the recovery in the present case does not fall in the category of commercial quantity.

In view of the specific stand taken by the learned counsel for the State that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.06.2022 is hereby made absolute.
