The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the impugned order dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-8), 29.04.2022 (Annexure P-9) and 07.06.2022 (Annexure P-10) vide which non bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioners in FIR No.207 dated 27.09.2019 under Sections 15, 22, 25 and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Sadar, Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

In furtherance of the order dated 14.06.2022 petitioner nos.1 & 2 have appeared before the Trial Court and were admitted to interim bail. So far as the petitioner no.3 is concerned, he has not complied with the said order. Therefore, the Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition qua petitioner no.3.

So far as the petitioner nos.1 & 2 are concerned since they have

already complied with the order dated 14.06.202, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. They shall carry on appearing before the Trial Court whereas the petition qua petitioner no.3 is hereby permitted to be dismissed as withdrawn.
