The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation through some senior officer or the CBI or retired District and Sessions Judge in case FIR No.15 dated 30.03.2021 registered under Sections 22, 25, 29 of NDPS Act and Section 473 IPC at Police Station Thulliwal, District Barnala.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner on the last five occasions.

The learned State counsel submits that after submission of the challan charges were framed on 04.01.2022 and the case is now pending for prosecution evidence on 04.11.2022. He contends as per the State's reply dated 22.02.2022, the husband of the petitioner namely, Major Singh is involved in one another case bearing FIR No.134 dated 25.07.2016 registered under Sections 18, 61, 85 NDPS Act, at Police Station Patran District Patiala. Accused Raja Singh @ Raju is involved

in three other cases bearing FIR No.242 dated 24.09.2014 registered under Sections 15, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala, FIR No.211 dated 16.07.2019 registered under Sections 22, 29, 61, 85 NDPS Act at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur and FIR No.25 dated 08.03.2020 registered under Sections 22, 29, 61, 85 NDPS Act at Police Station Passiana District Patiala.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court at this stage.
