ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for quashing of the order dated 19.03.2019 (P-1) and the order dated 09.04.2019 (P-4), passed by the learned JMIC, Hoshiarpur.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and order dated 19.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) and 09.04.2019 (Annexure P-4) are set aside with following observations:-

The accused/petitioner be permitted to lead his defence evidence and place on record the documents as mentioned in additional evidence application u/s 311 CrPC. It is further clarified that the accused shall not default a single appearance before the trial Court and the trial Court shall take up this matter on the day to day basis positively and decide the same on or before 30.09.2022. In case the accused fails to appear, the trial Court resort to issuance of non-bailable warrants against him and no adjournment shall be given to him.

Registry to communicate the copy of the order to the concerned trial Court. Learned counsel for the parties also to convey to the parties not to seek a single adjournment and complainant shall also ensure that no adjournment is sought on his behalf.

Petition is allowed in the terms mentioned above and interim orders are recalled. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
