The petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the DDR bearing No.03 dated 15.06.2021 as entered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, under Sections 323, 506, 341, 427, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 in the FIR bearing No.70 dated 14.06.2021 registered at the above-mentioned Police Station, under Sections 323, 324, 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh of the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in pursuance of the order dated 28.07.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is

not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

Keeping in view the above-said submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner vide the said order dated 28.07.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
