The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case GDR No.4 dated 27.02.2022 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 & 149 IPC P.S. Cheema District Sangrur in FIR No.24 dated 27.02.2022 under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149, 336, 506 IPC and Section 25 and 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 04.07.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 04.07.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 04.07.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
