Vide order dated 29.07.2021, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) was directed to file his own affidavit in reply to the petition, giving therein the status of investigation and the action taken in the matter.

In compliance to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Gulneet Singh Khurana, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) has been filed. The relevant para of the report is being reproduced hereunder:-

“Thus, on the basis of above said reasons, evidence on record the petitioner namely Nirvair Singh and his cousin Bikramjit Singh have been nominated in the FIR No.16(supra) and now efforts are being made to arrest them as they are absconding and on the other hand the accused Pargat Singh and Ranjit Kaur (respondents No.4 and 5) have been declared innocent. The true and translated copy of the detailed report of the SIT dated 31.08.2021 is attached as Annexure R-2/T and its vernacular is attached as Annexure R-2.”
