The prayer in the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.3 and 4 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner by providing adequate security/police protection to the petitioner as he received serious death threats from respondents No.5 to 7.

On 14.06.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 19.07.2022.

Mr. Karan Sharma, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and seeks time to file reply to the contentions raised in the Criminal Writ Petition.

Pending further orders, respondent No.3 shall dispose of the petitioner's application dt.02.06.2022 (Annexure P-4) seeking protection

of his life and liberty from respondents No.5 to 7,
and if need be, provide adequate protection if the
threat perception found to be true.”

Reply by way of affidavit of the Additional Superintendent of
Police, Panipat, dated 01.07.2022 has been filed.

A perusal of para 4 of the reply would reveal that the dispute
between the parties is purely civil in nature and to avoid any quarrel
proceedings under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C have been initiated against
respondent No.5 in the complaint No.1103-Peshi dated 30.05.2022. A
report in that regard is even attached herewith as Annexure R-3. It is further
found that there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioner at
the hands of respondents No.5 to 7 or anyone else.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be
passed in the present petition.

Petition stands disposed of.
