Petitioners seek protection of their life and liberty as they apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 as they are living in a live-in-relationship against the wishes of said respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners identifies the petitioners on the basis of documents attached. It is contended that petitioners are major, their dates of birth being 29.10.2002 and 06.07.2002, respectively. Aadhar cards of both the petitioners are appended with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively. They alleged that there is a threat to their life and liberty from respondents No.4 to 6, and in this regard they have submitted representation (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, for redressal of their grievance but no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

Mr.Karanbir Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Advance copy of the petition stands served.

In view of the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioners, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga is directed to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners, and take appropriate action if any/as may be required, keeping in view the alleged threat perception to the petitioners.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
