Vide the instant petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.89 dated 03.05.2022, Annexure P-1, registered under Sections 376, 506 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

State counsel has filed an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondent-State, which is taken on record. Upon instructions from ASI Ramlal, he submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Counsel for the complainant submits that she does not have any objection, in case the interim protection granted to the petitioner, is made absolute.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition, present petition is allowed and order dated 15.06.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
