The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.80 dated 11.04.2022 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC (lateron Section 306 IPC deleted and Section 304-B IPC added), registered at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala.

By virtue of the order dated 16.06.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 16.06.2022, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions, has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.
