Petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail.

A perusal of the paper-book would go on to show that the petitioner was released on interim bail on 08.10.2020 for a period of six months, on account of the fact that she was pregnant. Apparently, non-bailable warrants were issued on 27.04.2022 and the petitioner has availed the benefit of her freedom for the extended period due to Covid-19 pandemic. Apprehending arrest she had approached the Courts at Karnal, which has now dismissed the application for anticipatory bail on 04.06.2022. In such circumstances, apparently non-bailable warrants were issued to secure her presence.

Counsel could not point out from the file that the petitioner had ever been released on regular bail.

The petition is mis-conceived in the facts and circumstances and is dismissed in limine.
