This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioners from private respondents (arrayed in the petition), who have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents.

On 15.6.2022, the following order was passed:-

*“Counsel has relied upon judgment passed in the case of Kawaljeet Kaur and another v. State of Punjab and others; 2019 (4) R.C.R. (Civil) 364 to put forth the argument that if petitioner No.1 is below 21 years, protection can be obtained from the Constitutional Courts.*

*Notice of motion for 30.08.2022.*

*Mr. A.A. Pathak, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.*

*In the meantime, respondents No.2 and 3 shall look into the representation dated 12.06.2022 (Annexure P-6).*

*To await service upon private respondents. ”*

Learned State counsel has produced copy of the statements of petitioners wherein it has been stated that as on date, they do not need any security and in case need so arises they would approach the police authorities.

In view of the statement produced, no further directions are called for.

Disposed of.

Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
