1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.544 dated 31.12.2021 registered under Sections 171, 364-A, 379-A, 389, 420, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the co-accused of the petitioner from whom the recovery had been effected have already been granted concession of regular bail vide order dated 21.04.2021 passed in CRM-M-11475-2022 titled as '*Mukesh Kumar @ Pandit Vs. State of Haryana*' and vide order dated 27.05.2022 passed in '*CRM-M-22600-2022*' titled as Vishal Kumar Vs. State of Haryana. He contends that the case of the petitioner is at a better footing and as such, he deserves the parity to be extended to him.

3. On the aforesaid submission on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner, is not disputed by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

4. Taking into consideration, the period of custody, the stage of trial, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

5. The instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

6. The observation made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.

The petition is allowed.
