This application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for placing on record an affidavit (Annexure P-5) and representation (Annexure P-6).

In view of the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and affidavit as Annexure P-5 and representation as Annexure P-6 are taken on record.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action in accordance with law against private respondents No.6 & 7 on the basis of representation dated 01.07.2021 (Annexure P-2).

It has been stated in the petition that on 21.08.2020, respondents No.6 & 7 forcibly entered into the house of the petitioner without accompanying any female police official and gave beatings to the petitioner and her husband.

In pursuance to notice of motion, short reply dated 02.12.2021 by way of an affidavit of Sh. Sukhminder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Patiala has been filed on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and the same is already on the record. Relevant portion of the same is reproduced as under:-

XXXX

“That the brief facts of the case are that on 21-08 2020, at 08:34 hrs police party lead by ASI Karamjit Singh 139, Police Station City-1, Barnala approached the Police Station Sanaur for police help to arrest Kuldeep Singh (husband of the petitioner) s/o Satnam Singh R/o Village Sanaur in case FIR No. 505 dated 17-12-2019 u/s 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City-1, Barnala. Accordingly, SI Sukhwinder Kaur and Constable Harsimrat Singh 2338, PHG Nirmal Singh 18039 were sent alongwith police party lead by ASI Karamjit Singh 139, Police Station City-1, Barnala. In this regard DDR No. 7 dated 21-08-2020 was recorded in Roznamcha, P.S. Sanaur. Copy of the DDR is attached herewith as Annexure R-1.

That ASI Karamjit Singh 139, Police Station City-1, Barnala alongwith police party and officials of P.S. Sanaur conducted raid at the residence of the petitioner to arrest her husband -Kuldeep Singh. Kuldeep Singh met present in the house. Who was made aware about the registration of above noted case at P.S. City-1, Barnala. But Kuldeep Singh raised hue and cry at the spot to escape from his arrest and collected his brothers and other persons at the spot. Thereafter, Kuldeep Singh said to the petitioner to torn her clothes. The brother of Kuldeep Singh and other persons also supported the petitioner. In this regard information was given to senior officer by ASI Karamjit Singh. The departure of the police party lead by ASI Karamjit Singh was recorded in Roznamcha, P.S. Sanaur. Copy of the DDR No. 10 dated 21-08-2020 is attached herewith as Annexure R-2.”

The aforesaid facts have not been controverted by the petitioner.

In view of the what has been stated above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case and, consequently, the same is disposed off accordingly.
