Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Section 21(1) of Mines & Minerals (Regulations & Development) Act,, 1957 and Section 379 of IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 83, dated 05.06.2022, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 17.06.2022, passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, confirms the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of

investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the ad-interim order dated 17.06.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of.
