Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 181 dated 14.11.2021, registered under Section 302 IPC and Sections 21, 27, 29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla (earlier District Sangrur).

Vide order dated 16.06.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 16.06.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Janpal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 16.06.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
