Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.41 dated 2.4.2019 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

By virtue of the order dated 23.5.2019, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 23.5.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He submits that the matter was referred to the Mediation Centre and the same was amicably settled there.

Report of the Mediator dated 7.2.2022 has also been placed on record, which would affirm the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been amicably settled.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh has endorsed the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.5.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
