As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant.

As per statement of the parents of the appellant, real name of the Milan is Devansh Kumar, which is mentioned in his Aadhar Card and the cheque be also issued in the name of Devansh Kumar.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) in the name of appellant-Devansh Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 26.09.2022 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Learned counsel for the appellant has pointed out that FAO Nos.121, 122 and 123 of 2005, which has been filed against the same award are pending consideration of this Hon'ble Court and request the same be put up before this Forum.

Registry is directed to put the aforesaid appeals for 29.08.2022.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
