MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.120 dated 23.05.2021 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad, who apprehends their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 09.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioner Nos.2 to 4 have already been arrested and qua them the petition is rendered infructuous. He further submits that the offence punishable under Section 325 IPC was added subsequently and the cross-case lodged on behalf of the petitioners has also been cancelled.

The above factual aspect is not disputed by learned State counsel.

Adjourned to 21.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner No.1, namely, Rahul shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner No.1 associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.11.2021 is made absolute.
