In the petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1 on account of their marriage, which has taken place on 12.06.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.S. Paul, APP, U.T. Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3 and submits that it has been verified that respondent Nos.4 and 5 have got their statements recorded before the police authorities that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners.

Keeping in view the above, this Court is of the considered opinion that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly. The private respondents, however, are held out to their assurance recorded before the police authorities. U.T. Chandigarh shall take appropriate action in accordance with law, if so required.
