This order shall dispose of three different bail petitions filed by Deepanshu son of Mukesh, Vijay @ Bobby son of Rajbir and Vishal @ Monu son of Jaiprakash Sharma in a case arising from FIR No.341, 23.07.2020, under Sections 302, 34 of the IPC (Sections 148, 149 & 120-B of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Deepanshu and Vijay @ Bobby are in custody, since 02.08.2020 whereas Vishal @ Monu is in custody, since 20.08.2020.

As per the case of prosecution, the case was registered on the basis of information given by Sh. Amardeep son of Ram Kunwar. He has stated that his brother Deepak Sharma was walking in the School Ground when he heard noise of quarrel and on reaching there he noticed that Surender son of Permanand @ Parma and Dhamu son of Surender and third unknown person armed with wooden sticks and sharpened weapons, had inflicted injuries on Deepak Sharma from their respective weapon. The moment the first informant reached and started making noise, all the three accused ran away along with their respective weapons after leaving their motorcycle.

After a period of two days, a supplementary statement of the first informant was recorded in which he sought to implicate four other accused including the petitioners. In the supplementary statement, it has been stated that all the accused came on two different motorcycles and killed his brother Deepak Sharma.

As already noticed all the petitioners have suffered

incarceration for a period of more than one year and five months. The petitioners do not have a criminal past. The conclusion of trial is likely to take a long time. It is alleged by the prosecution that on the disclosure statement of the petitioners a wooden stick each has been recovered from the petitioners apart from a motorcycle from Vishal @ Monu.

The conclusion of trial is likely to take a long time. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, further incarceration of the petitioners shall not be appropriate. Hence, they are directed to be released on a regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petitions are allowed with the aforesaid directions.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
