In view of the oral agreed statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a total sum of Rs.80,000/- i.e. Rs.44,882/- (Rupees Forty Four thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Two Only) over and above the amount of Rs.35,178/-already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to the appellant, as full and final settlement of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/draft in the sum of Rs.44,882/- (Rupees Forty Four thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Two Only) in favour of the appellant with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks from today. In case, the amount is not deposited within the prescribed period, the appellant shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on the said amount from the date of this order till the date of realisation. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the

cheque/draft bearing signatures of the learned counsel for appellant as a receipt on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.
