Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.126 dated 18.06.2021, under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Line Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 29.07.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 29.07.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and appeared before the Mediation Centre as well, however, the same remained unsuccessful and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

The report of the Mediator is taken on record showing that no mediation settlement is possible at this stage.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harpal, affirmed the fact that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the attending circumstances, the matter needs to be investigated and case be decided on merits. Accordingly, interim order dated 29.07.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
