[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 09.02.2022 in CRWP No.1178 of 2022 in case titled as Gurmukh Singh vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CRWP No.1178 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to take a decision on representation dated 07.01.2022 filed by the petitioner within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order in accordance with law.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 09.02.2022, needful has been done and FIR No.62 dated 05.03.2022 registered under Sections 452/323/324/506 at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran against the persons qua whom the petitioner had given representation and that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for

grant of liberty to challenge the action of the respondent in registering DDR No.28 dated 22.05.2022 under Sections 323/324/326 and 506 IPC at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran against him by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
