AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to official respondents No. 2 to 4 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No. 5 to 7.

As per the pleadings, son of the petitioner is an accused in three FIRs. The petitioner has disowned his son and is being harassed by the respondents No. 5 to 7 by calling him to the police station.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice, on instructions from ASI-Baldev Singh refutes the allegations and submits that the petitioner was never called to the police station. He further submits that as on date the petitioner is not required in any case and in case the presence of the petitioner is required, he would be called only after complying the procedure as per law.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of.
