The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 praying for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 39 dated 24.02.2022 registered under Sections 392 and 473 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Division No.5, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

A perusal of the status report filed by way of affidavit of Harish Behl, PPS, ACP (Civil Lines), Ludhiana shows that the petitioner is involved in 03 other cases.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant petition and seeks withdrawal thereof and prays that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender within a period of 10 days and in the event of the surrender by the petitioner, the bail petition so preferred may be decided expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the authorities within a period of 10 days from today, the bail petition, if any, preferred by the petitioner may be decided expeditiously and preferably within a period of 05 working days.
