By way of the instant petition, the petitioner seeks the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on her representation Annexure P-2, while averring that respondent No.4 is her daughter-in-law and she has been threatening and harassing her (petitioner) by proclaiming that she would commit suicide and would get her implicated in some criminal case and though she has moved the afore-said representation in this regard but the police has not taken any action on the same.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and he submits that he has no objection in the

issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to look into representation Annexure P-2 as moved by the petitioner and to decide the same.

Keeping in view the above-discussed limited prayer as made by the petitioner in the present petition as well as the submission as made by learned State counsel, the petition in hand is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the afore-said representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and to decide the same, in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the present matter, as expeditiously as possible.
