Instant petition has been filed seeking a mandamus for directing the respondent-authorities under the Excise and Taxation Department, State of Haryana to issue F-Forms in favour of the petitioner-company pertaining to the assessment year 2016-17.

As per counsel representing the petitioner-company the respondents are obligated to issue such F-Forms in the light of Section 6A read with Rule 12 (5) of the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956/(Registration Turnover) Rules, 1957.

Counsel has also invited our attention to a representation dated 15.09.2021 at Annexure P-7 that had been submitted to the Excise and Taxation Officer-cum-Assessing Authority, Panchkula. It is contended that till date no action thereupon has been taken.

Since an advance copy of the writ petition had already been served upon the State of Haryana, Mr. Apoorv Garg, learned DAG, Haryana enters appearance.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Ms. Manisha Aggarwal, ETO, Panchkula who is present in Court, makes a statement that the representation dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-7) is pending consideration as of date and the same would be considered in accordance with law and a final view would be taken and communicated to the petitioner-company within a period of three weeks from today.

Statement is accepted.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Petition disposed of.

It is clarified that we have not examined the prayer of the petitioner on merits.
