Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.0158 dated 03.06.2022 under Sections 186, 188, 189, 353, 34, 504 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Nuh, District Nuh.

Vide order dated 20.06.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.06.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Arun Kumar has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.06.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
