This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.135 dated 18.10.2020 registered under Sections 21(c), 25, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985 and Sections 307, 353, 333, 186, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station S.T.F. Phase 4, Mohali, S.A.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.
