The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 132 dated 02.04.2022 registered under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 20.06.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel on instruction from Sub Inspector Tej Singh corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of

investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant vehemently argues that the suicide note specifically names the petitioner and Kamal who have given beating to the deceased on the day of the occurrence and he said that he cannot live in the said situation and that the same would duly constitute abetment of the offence.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 20.06.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
