1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.11.2019, in CWP-32555-2019

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-32555-2019, was disposed of vide order dated 08.11.2019, by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 04.07.2019, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefits after decision of the legal notice, to pay the same to the petitioner, within three months thereafter.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondents have decided legal notice dated 04.07.2019 and released the benefits to the petitioner as per his entitlement, in terms of the claim made, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be

permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
