This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and for issuance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case the petitioner is required to be called / summoned to Crime Branch, Mohali, at the instance of respondent no.4.
