The petitioner herein has sought the relief of pre-arrest/ anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.322 dated 19.12.2020 registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Jawahar Singh from the afore-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 04.07.2022 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

3. Keeping in view of the above-discussed submission as made

by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 04.07.2022, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
