This is the second petition filed by the petitioner praying for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.375 dated 10.12.2021, under Sections 323, 498-A, 377, 406, 506, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Ram Nagar, Karnal.

The petitioner approached this Court on the earlier occasion by filing CRM-M No.19426-2022 and after arguing at length, the same was allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn on 09.05.2022. The petitioner has again approached this Court by way of present petition praying for the same relief. It has been contended by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The marriage of the petitioner took place with the complainant on 24.10.2020. However, later on as contended, a matrimonial discord took place due to the unreasonable behaviour of the complainant and despite best efforts of the petitioner, the same could not be resolved. Thus, the complainant filed the FIR on the false and frivolous allegations. He submits that the petitioner

has tried his best to settle the dispute amicably but the complainant did not cooperate for the same.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record, it is apparent that the petitioner has approached this Court on the earlier occasion by way of filing CRM-M-19426-2022, however, after arguing for some time, the same was withdrawn. Thus, the petition was allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn on 09.05.2022. The petitioner has approached this Court again. Needless to say that with no change of circumstances, filing of successive anticipatory bail application cannot be allowed. In view of the facts and circumstances of the present case and the law settled, this Court do not find any merit in the petition. Thus, this petition being without any merit, is hereby dismissed.
