The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of order dated 09.03.2022 by which bail and surety bonds of the petitioner has been cancelled in FIR No. 39 dated 02.04.2020 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, at police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and has furnished the bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court on 29.06.2022 and that he has been admitted to interim bail by the said Court.

The aforesaid fact has not been controverted by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 20.06.2022 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
