By way of the present petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has prayed for quashing of FIR No. 102 dated 07.04.2017, registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

In terms of order dated 06.12.2022, Mr. Surender Pal Singh, IPC, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Panchkula is present in Court along with an affidavit, vide which in para 5, the details of the investigation is given and it is stated that there was unreasonable delay on the part of the police officials and in this regard, an explanation has been called from them, vide office memo No. 1977/ST, DCP, Panchkula dated 09.12.2022 and after receiving the explanation, suitable departmental action shall be taken, as per law. It is further stated in the affidavit that on 08.12.2022, the cancellation report stands approved and the same has been ordered to be submitted before the

Illaqua Magistrate at Panchkula.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of at this stage, with liberty to petitioner to approach the trial, in accordance with law.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

The petitioner will also be at liberty to file a fresh petition, if so required.
