AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking quashing of order dated 29.3.2022, vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed person in complaint No. NACT No. 341 of 2019 in FIR No. 176 dated 7.4.2022, under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that to show his *bona fide*, the petitioner is ready to deposit Rs.60,000/- with the trial court subject to out-come of the trial. He further submits that proper summons were not issued for proclamation.

Let the petitioner appear before the trial court within ten days from today. On his deposit of Rs.60,000/-, he shall be released on bail. The amount so deposited shall be subject to out-come of the trial and be kept in FDR in a nationalised Bank. The court will be at liberty to impose such conditions as deemed necessary to ensure presence of the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of.
