The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking permission to place on record the copy of DD. No. 13 dated 09.07.2018 registered under Section 182 IPC at Police Station Ambala City as Annexure A-1.

Application is allowed as prayed for and copy of DD. No. 13 dated 09.07.2018 registered under Section 182 IPC at Police Station Ambala City is taken on record as Annexure A-1.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of directions to

respondents No.1 to 5 to change the status of the vehicle bearing registration No. HR-01-AH 7482, model No.2014, Engine No. 45996 Chassis No. 23399 with the National Crimes Record Bureau.

It has been averred and argued by the counsel for the petitioner that she had purchased the above vehicle from respondent No.6 on payment of complete sale consideration on 29.03.2014. The requisite documents pertaining to the transaction have also been appended with the present petition. However, the respondent No.6 got lodged FIR No. 446 dated 05.12.2014 under Section 379 in Police Station Ambala City against the petitioner. The complete particulars of the transaction was shown to the police whereupon a cancellation report is stated to have been prepare. He submits that when the petitioner wanted to further sale the property, it transpired that the status of the motorcycle has been shown as stolen in the Crimes Record Bureau. As the representation of the petitioner for correction of the record failed to evince any response, the present petition was filed.

Pursuant to the directions issued by this Court, a reply by way of affidavit of Sultan Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala was filed wherein it was acknowledged by the respondent-State that the police had prepared a cancellation report in the case sent to the senior officers for approval alongwith recommendation for preparing kalandra under Section 182 IPC against respondent No.6 for giving false complaint to the police.

A further status report by way of affidavit of Joginder Sharma, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Amabla has also been filed wherein it has been averred that the said cancellation report was duly

accepted by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala on 28.04.2022 and a request for updating the data of vehicle of the petitioner on the portal of National Crimes Record Bureau has been forwarded by the Director State Crimes Record Bureau, Haryana. It is expected that the necessary changes of the data shall thus been carried out in due course.

In view of the subsequent developments, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage.

Needless to mention that the appropriate updation of the data on the National Crimes Record Bureau shall be undertaken by the authorities expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

Petition is disposed of as not pressed.
