RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Certiorari to call for the records of the case/application No.21/2019 (Annexure P-1) pending with respondent No.1 with a prayer to quash the direction of respondent No.1 dated 09.05.2019 (Annexure P-4), with a further prayer to direct the respondent No.1 to decide the objections of the petitioner dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-3).

The counsel for respondent No.2, on instructions from respondent No.2, who is present in the Court submits that he will pay an amount of Rs.70,000/- to the petitioner as a settlement amount, for settling the disputes between the parties regarding the loan amount involved in the present case. The counsel for respondent No.2 has further submitted that he will also withdraw all the proceedings instituted by him against the petitioner regarding the loan amount involved in the present case.

The counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from Mr. Ishwar Singh, Assistant Registrar, who is present in the Court, accepts the aforesaid offer. He has further submitted that if the amount is paid by respondent No.2, as undertaken by him, then the petitioner will also withdraw all the cases pending between the parties regarding the loan amount involved in the present case.

Since, the matter stands settled between the parties for an amount of Rs.70,000/-, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to pay an amount of Rs.70,000/- to the petitioner, within a period of two months from today.

It is further ordered that the parties shall be bound by their respective undertakings to withdraw all the cases against each other on completion of payment of Rs.70,000/- as ordered above.
