The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.16 dated 2.2.2019 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B of IPC and Section 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983 and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals Regulation Act, 2014, at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

On 25.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his client is ready and willing to amicably resolve the dispute with the complainant and to show his *bonafide* he has produced a demand draft for an amount of Rs.1.5 lakhs in favour of the complainant.

Without prejudice to the complainant's claim and rights, learned counsel for the complainant submits that his client is ready to accept the aforesaid demand draft and thereafter is also ready and willing to amicably resolve the dispute with the petitioner.

In the light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over to learned counsel for the complainant the aforesaid demand draft and after the needful has been done, to make an attempt to amicably resolve their dispute, the parties are directed to appear before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court on 09.12.2021 at 10 am.

To await the report of the mediation, adjourned to 15.02.2022.

To facilitate the mediation proceedings, subject to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar, till the adjourned date, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail.”

Pursuant to the afore quoted order, the Mediator has filed his report as per which, through compromise/ settlement dated 9.2.2022, the petitioner and the complainant have resolved their dispute.

In the light of the above and holding both parties to remain bound by the terms of the afore compromise/settlement, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide the afore quoted order dated 25.11.2021 is ordered to be made absolute.
