The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 173 dated 02.08.2018, registered under Section 380 IPC (later on added Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC) at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 14.06.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with the intervention of the respectable of the area, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 2 does not dispute the factum of compromise.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the contents of the FIR.

As the FIR, which is sought to be quashed is registered under Section 380 IPC, this Court does not find any ground to quash the same on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
