The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to extend the period of parole for further period of two months.

A perusal of the present petition shows that even though the instant petition for seeking extension of parole has been filed on the medical ground of alleged surgery pertaining to the mother of the petitioner, however, no such documents as would show the immediate prescription of an urgent surgery to be performed on the mother of the petitioner have been appended with the instant petition. The medical prescription appended along with the petition as Annexure P-2 pertains to the year 2019 and 2020.

In the absence of the details pertaining to the current medical scenario and the medical advise pertaining to the surgery to be performed, it is not possible for the Court to seek verification as to whether the surgery in question is actually required to be performed or not. Apart therefrom, the instant petition is also missing in the essential details as to the place/hospital where the surgery is to be performed and as to whether the mother of the petitioner has already been

admitted in the hospital considering that the case of the petitioner is that the surgery is scheduled for day after.

Learned counsel for the petitioner thus seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a petition afresh with better and complete particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
