Petitioner has approached this Court praying for quashing the order dated 29.09.2011 by virtue of which he was declared proclaimed offender.

This Court vide order dated 18th March, 2016 directed the petitioner to appear before the concerned Court on 1st April, 2016. On her appearance, she was directed to be admitted to interim bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the said order, petitioner duly appeared before the Court and she was admitted to bail and hence, the P.O. proceedings against the petitioner were dropped. He submits that his only prayer in this petition survives *qua* filing the cancellation report which though prepared but has not been filed till date in the court of competent jurisdiction.

Learned State counsel has produced on record the zimni order dated 31.03.2022 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar which would read that no further order has been received from the Hon'ble

High Court and the same be awaited till 30th July, 2022.

From the perusal of the file, it is apparent that there is no interim stay granted by this Court since the pendency of the petition before this Court. Hence, the Court below is at liberty to proceed with the cancellation report filed before it.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, this petition survives only *qua* the prayer of deciding the cancellation report and as such the same is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the proceedings regarding the cancellation report filed before it within a month from today.
