This is the 02nd petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos.4 to 12.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the UT Chandigarh has apprised the Court that the petitioners were not found residing at the given address and also their mobile phones were found switched off and were not reachable. He further contends that they have been able to reach out to the petitioners yesterday and have called upon them to appear before the agency so that their grievance can be looked into.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes that the parties shall appear before the SHO, Police Station Sector 11 Chandigarh on 24.06.2022 at 11:00 AM.

Learned counsel for the UT Chandigarh further points out that upon the petitioners appearing before the SHO, Police Station Sector 11 Chandigarh,

appropriate action in accordance with law shall be taken.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present case.

Instant petition is disposed of in terms as aforesaid.
