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**PANKAJ JAIN, J. (ORAL)**

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.449 dated 14.10.2021 registered under Sections 392, 397, 201 IPC and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Jind Sadar, District Jind, Haryana.

Custody certificate dated 27.08.2022 by way of an affidavit of Sandeep Dangi, Dsp, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Jind), Haryana has been filed. The same is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 10 months and 7 days as under trial.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the challan already stands presented. There is no other case against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel opposes the same and submits that the country made pistol along with one live cartridge which was used in the offence stands recovered, though challan has been presented but evidence is yet to be recorded. Owing to the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner there is every apprehension that the petitioner may tamper with the evidence.

The petitioner is in custody since 19.10.2021. Challan already stands presented. There is nothing on record to support the apprehension raised by the State viz. tampering of evidence by the petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Needless to say anything recorded herein shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
