The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 praying for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0027 dated 10.04.2022 registered under Sections 458, 341, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Section 326 of the IPC was added later on) at Police Station Balachour, District SBS Nagar (Annexure P-1).

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition. However, he seeks indulgence that in the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court within a period of 04 days from today, the trial Court may be directed to decide the regular bail of the petitioner expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to mention that in the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court within 04 days, his regular bail petition, if so preferred, shall be decided expeditiously and preferably within a period of 05 working days.
