Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the order dated 24.02.2022 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **Gajan Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others**, CWP-3641-2022, whereby similar petition was disposed of granting liberty to the petitioners to avail civil remedies in accordance with law.

In the present case, the petitioner is seeking adequate compensation for the damages caused to her property by the respondents while demolishing the same. A further direction is sought to be issued to the respondents to re-construct the structure of the petitioner.

With regard to her grievance, petitioner has got served a legal notice dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-4) upon the respondents, however, no action has been taken thereon till date.
