Petitioner approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0026 dated 03.03.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 06.01.2022, the petitioner was granted interim order with direction to join investigation subject to the conditions made under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

On 31.05.2022, learned counsel for the complainant submitted before this Court that the petitioner has violated the terms and conditions of the interim order granted vide order dated 06.01.2022 and the Court directed the State to verify the contentions raised by counsel for the complainant.

The State has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Joginder Pal (PPS) Assistant Commissioner of Police, PBI-CAW & Children Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the factum was verified and as per the verification report, the petitioner after having been granted the anticipatory bail on 06.01.2022, left the country for USA on 20.05.2022 and returned to India on 28.06.2022. It has also submitted that while leaving the country, he has not obtained the permission from this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner failed to controvert the same. The Court is satisfied that the petitioner has flatly violated the terms and conditions of the interim order granted to the petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail. Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed.
